General Description:

The professional development initiative, launched in spring 2010, provides funding to Education Service Centers (ESCs) to provide Texas Essential Knowledge and Skills (TEKS) professional development training to all eligible teachers, teacher leaders, and administrators. Training is provided in both face-to-face and online formats. Training is provided at no cost to participants.

Authority:

General Appropriations Act (GAA), Article III, Rider 42, 81st Texas Legislature, 2009

Goals/Objectives/Requirements:

ESCs are required to meet the following goals:

- Provide training to as many eligible participants teachers, teacher leaders, and administrators as possible. (Teacher leaders are individuals who may not work directly with students but who work primarily with content area teachers as mentors, coaches, strategists, coordinators, etc.) Training will be provided at no cost to participants.
- Expand participants' knowledge of TEKS specific to teaching/supervisory assignments.
- Expand participants' knowledge of English Language Proficiency Standards (ELPS) and the College and Career Readiness Standards (CCRS), how those standards interconnect with content area TEKS, and how those standards relate to classroom instruction.
- Expand participants' knowledge of the Response to Intervention (RtI) model and how that model can be implemented across K-12 education.
- Impact instructional/supervisory practices of participants in order to ensure effective classroom instruction for all students.
