Moms Caravan Heads to the Border

Moms for America (MFA) and Black Women Walk announced today they, and moms from around the country, will travel to the Texas-Mexico border this Saturday, November 3rd to meet with families who experience the impact of illegal crossings first-hand, in an effort to share their stories with the American people.

As the migrant caravan from Honduras presses on-wards towards the U.S. border, many of our country's politicians continue to bury their heads in the sand about the illegal immigration crisis our nation is facing – **but we moms refuse to ignore these problems.**

MFA President Kimberly Fletcher released the following statement ahead of the Moms Caravan: "Protecting our borders is something of grave concern to mothers on both sides of the border. No one is covering the moms' view in the news. No one is even asking moms what they think about the 'caravan' or how it affects the women and children on the other side of the border.

"These families on the border did not ask to be thrown into a political fight. They did not ask to be on the front lines on this battle for our nation's border security. Our country and its leadership must take a strong stance against this impending threat to our national security, because border families have fallen victim to this system that has been broken for far too long."

During the visit MFA will also interview several "Angel Families", as they know all too well the dangers that an unsecured border can cause to Americans. Joining the Caravan is a Gold Star mother, and representatives from Moms for America, Moms March Movement, Fund the Wall, Women on the Wall, Black Women Walk, and the Remembrance Project.

During the visit MFA, will be joined by a Gold Star mother, Fund the Wall, Women on the Wall, Black Women on the Walk, and the Remembrance Project as they interview Angel Moms.

"Moms for America looks forward to meeting with these border moms to hear their side of this story, and sharing the story that the mainstream media so obviously doesn't want you to hear," added Fletcher.
